




Our faith is central to who we are.

Mary is also active in the church. She leads the music on Sunday mornings and is loved by many in the church.








MANY NIGHTS WE ENJOY HANGING ON THE COUCH AND WATCHING A MOVIE Music has been a big part of our lives.



the kindness and compassion he was treating me


with was the same kindness and compassion that he

 - 2. As Christians, we believe that we are spiritually adopted into Jesus' family, and we wish to physically extend the same love and compassion to your child.
- **OPENNESS TO BIRTHPARENT(S)** / While we can never truly know what an expectant parent is going through, we respect and value every person that is going through this process. Our hope is that we can walk alongside the birth parent(s) and build strong relationships. We want to know everything we can about our future child's life and want to be able to foster a relationship between him/her and the birth parent(s).

This would mean that we want to be present through the pre-birth process, and we want to keep open lines of communication during the child's life, as much as is healthy and safe for the child. The specific details of the relationship will depend on many factors—including situations, locations, and the comfort levels of everyone involved. But we do hope to foster as much of a relationship as is good for the child.

• CHILDCARE PLANS / Both of us work from home, and J.'s schedule is usually pretty flexible, so we hope to provide most of the childcare ourselves. But, when we need help, we are part of a great community through our church and town. There are many older couples in our church who would love to help look after the child early on. As the child grows, there is a great daycare in town, and a good school walking distance from our house (J. subs at the school from time to time, so he can attest to love and care of the staff firsthand).
