Many of my favorite childhood memories were made during that time.

Things changed in late middle school when difficult circumstances led to my sisters and me being removed from my father's care. We moved to Castle Rock with my stepmom, where I finished school and grew into my teenage years. Growing up, I experienced both stability and hardship—love and loss—and those experiences shaped my heart in lasting ways. I understand what it feels like to long for belonging, to crave safety, and to hope for a place to call home.
