OUR LOVE Story










PUMPKIN PATCH TOGETHER








We live in a beautiful modern Craftsman style 4 bedroom, 3 bathroom home that we renovated.




Adeline


Our second daughter is Charlotte.

My favorite things to do in this world are our daily walks and playing with my favorite humans.


Eleanor

We promise to stay involved in a community of other adoptive families.




WE LOVE ALL THINGS DISNEY
