

We are tremendously excited to share our lives with another child.








WE MET AT CHURCH...

MEET Liam





KENSI AND NOVA LOVE TO PLAY IN THE SAND








We live in a small town in southern Indiana.


We are the parents who will love our children first and foremost, no matter what.
